Ehud Frees Israel

Lesson Text: Judges 3:15-25, 29-30

GOLDEN TEXT: "When the children of Israel cried unto the Lord, the Lord raised them up a deliverer, Ehud the son of Gera, a Benjamite" (Judges 3:15).

JUDG. 3:15 But when the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, the LORD raised them up a deliverer, Ehud the son of Gera, a Benjamite, a man lefthanded: ad by him the children of Israel sent a present unto Eglon the king of Moab.

- 16 But Ehud made him a dagger which had two edges, of a cubit length; and he did gird it under his raiment upon his right thigh.
- 17 And he brought the present unto Eglon king of Moab: and Eglon was a very fat man.
- 18 And when he had made an end to offer the present, he sent away the people that bare the present.
- 19 But he himself turned again from the quarries that were by Gilgail, and said, I have a secret errand unto thee, O king: who said, Keep silence. And all that stood by him went out from him.
- 20 And Ehud came unto him; and he was sitting in a summer parlour, which he had for himself alone. And Ehud said, I have a message from God unto thee. And he arose out of his seat.
- 21 And Ehud put forth his left hand, and took the dagger from his right thigh, and thrust
- 22 And the haft also went in after the blade; and the fat closed upon the blade, so that he could not draw the dagger out of his belly; and the dirt came out.
- 23 Then Ehud went forth through the porch, and shut the doors of the parlour upon him, and

locked them.

- 24 When he was gone out, his servants came; and when they saw that, behold, he doors of the parlour were locked, they said, Surely he covereth his feet in his summer chamber.
- 25 And they tarried till they were ashamed: and, behold, he opened not the doors of the parlour; therefore they took a key, and opened them: and, behold, their lord was fallen down dead on the earth.
- 29 And they slew of Moab at that time about ten thousand men, all lusty, and all men of valour; and thee escaped not a man.
- 30 So Moab was subdued that day under the hand of Israel. And the land had rest fourscore years.
