

# GENEALOGY OF JESUS

- Matthew lists Jesus' genealogy from Abraham to Jesus.
- Luke lists Jesus' genealogy from Jesus to Adam.



The angel Gabriel tells
Zechariah that his wife

#### **KEY IDEA**

Their son will be named John and he will prepare the way for the Messiah.







Annunciation: The angel Gabriel tells Mary that she will bear a son through the Holy Spirit.

#### **KEY IDEA**

"He . . . will be called the Son of the Most High."

**FOUND IN** Lk. 1:26–38

Mary visits Elizabeth and sings a song of praise (the Magnificat).

#### **KEY IDEA**

"My soul magnifies the Lord."

**FOUND IN** Lk. 1:39–56



John the Baptist is born to Elizabeth and Zechariah.

#### **KEY IDEA**

The Lord's hand was with the newborn child.




An angel tells Joseph in a dream to take Mary as his wife.

#### **KEY IDEA**

The child will be called *Immanuel*, "God with us" (see Isa. 7:14).

**FOUND IN Mt.** 1:18–25



#### **Birth of Christ:**

Because of a Roman census, Joseph and Mary travel to Bethlehem. Jesus is born in Bethlehem of Judea.

#### **KEY IDEA**

Prophecy is fulfilled as Jesus is born in the city of David (see Micah 5:2).



Nearby shepherds visit Jesus after being told of his birth by angels.

#### **KEY IDEA**

"Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you."





As an infant, Jesus is brought to the temple in Jerusalem for dedication.

#### **KEY IDEA**

Simeon and Anna recognize Jesus as the Messiah.



**FOUND IN** Lk. 2:21–38



Magi (wise men) from the east visit Jesus in Bethlehem.



#### **KEY IDEA**

The magi worship Jesus and present him with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

**FOUND IN Mt. 2:1–12** 



Joseph, Mary, and Jesus flee to Egypt to escape King Herod who plans to kill the newborn "king of the Jews."

#### **KEY IDEA**

The prophecy of Hosea is fulfilled: "Out of Egypt I called my son" (Hos. 11:1).

**FOUND IN Mt. 2:13–18** 

After Herod's death, Joseph, Mary, and Jesus return to Nazareth.

#### **KEY IDEA**

Jesus is raised in Nazareth of Galilee.



At age twelve, Jesus amazes teachers at the temple in Jerusalem during Passover.

#### **KEY IDEA**

"Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man."

# **KEY IDEA**


A voice from heaven proclaims, "You are my Son, whom I love."

Prophets who challenged the ruling authorities were not tolerated.




**FOUND IN** Lk. 3:19–20



People bring Jesus those who are ill and demon-possessed.




**FOUND IN** Mt. 8:14–17; Mk. 1:29–30; Lk. 4:38–44

**FOUND IN** Mt. 8:1–4; Mk. 1:40–45; Lk. 5:12–16



Jesus heals and forgives a paralyzed man.

#### **KEY IDEA**

"Son, your sins are forgiven."

Jesus has authority to forgive sins.



Jesus calls Matthew (Levi) a tax collector, and dines with sinners in Matthew's home.



"I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners."





People ask Jesus about fasting: "How is it that we and the Pharisees fast often, but your disciples do not fast?"

**FOUND IN** Mt. 9:14–17; Mk. 2:18–22; Lk. 5:33–39

#### **KEY IDEA**

"You don't put new wine in old wineskins."





Jesus heals a man at the pool of Bethesda on the Sabbath.



Jesus claims to be the Son of God.







On the Sabbath, Jesus' disciples pick some grain, and Jesus heals a man's hand.

The Pharisees accuse them of breaking the Sabbath.

**FOUND IN** Mt. 12:1–14; Mk. 2:23–3:6; Lk. 6:1–11

#### **KEY IDEA**

"The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath."





Large crowds seek out Jesus.

## **KEY IDEA**

Jesus healed all who were ill but warned them not to tell others about him.



**FOUND IN** Mt. 12:15–21; Mk. 3:7–12; Lk. 6:17–19



Jesus appoints the twelve disciples.

A house divided cannot stand; a tree is known by its fruit.




Jesus predicts his death.

**FOUND IN Mt.** 12:38–45; Lk. 11:29–32






Jesus predicts his death.

News of Jesus' power and authority spread.






Jesus raises Jairus's daughter and heals a woman who touches his cloak.


