"I am sending you out like sheep among wolves."




Herod Antipas has John the Baptist executed.

FOUND IN Mt. 14:13–21; Mk. 6:30–44; Lk. 9:10–17; Jn. 6:1–15







Jesus walks on water on the Sea of Galilee.

KEY IDEA

Honor Jesus from your heart.



Jesus heals a woman's daughter in the region of Tyre and Sidon.

KEY IDEA

A non-Israelite shows great faith in Jesus.




Jesus heals a deaf and mute man.

KEY IDEA

"Be opened!"



FOUND IN Mk. 7:31–37



The Pharisees and Sadducees ask Jesus for a sign.

KEY IDEA

No sign given except the sign of Jonah.

"Be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees."



Jesus heals a blind man at Bethsaida.

KEY IDEA

Jesus tells the man not to announce his healing.



FOUND IN Mk. 8:22–26




Peter calls Jesus the Messiah—the Christ.

KEY IDEA

"You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."



Jesus predicts his death and resurrection.



KEY IDEA

"The Son of Man must suffer many things."

FOUND IN Mt. 16:21–28; Mk. 8:31–9:1; Lk. 9:22–27



The Transfiguration:

Jesus is seen in glory. Moses and Elijah appear.

KEY IDEA

A voice from a cloud proclaims, "This is my Son, whom I love."

FOUND IN Mt. 17:1–13; Mk. 9:2–13; Lk. 9:28–36



Jesus heals a boy who is possessed by a demon.

KEY IDEA

Faith as small as a mustard seed moves mountains.

FOUND IN Mt. 17:14–20, (v. 21*); Mk. 9:14–29; Lk. 9:37–43

Again, Jesus predicts his death and resurrection.

KEY IDEA

Jesus will be killed and on the third day be raised to life.



Jesus teaches about the temple tax, children, true greatness, and mercy.

KEY IDEA

"It is the one who is least among you all who is the greatest."





KEY PLACES

Jerusalem Bethany Jericho



Jesus heads south toward Jerusalem.

KEY IDEA

Jesus' ministry shifts from Galilee to Judea and Perea ("across the Jordan").



Jesus teaches about the cost of following him.

KEY IDEA

"The Son of Man has no place to lay his head."



Jesus teaches in the temple courts in Jerusalem.

KEY IDEA


"I am not here on my own authority."



In the temple courts, Jesus spares a woman who was caught in adultery.

KEY IDEA

The Pharisees are outwitted by Jesus.



FOUND IN Jn. 7:53–8:11*

Jesus has disputes with the Pharisees at the temple courts.

KEY IDEA

God the Father has sent Jesus.

Jesus tells the Pharisees, "If you knew me, you would know my Father also."



Jesus sends out the seventytwo.

KEY IDEA

The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few.





Jesus tells the parable of the good Samaritan.

KEY IDEA

"Love your neighbor as yourself."








Jesus visits the home of Martha and Mary in Bethany.

"Mary has chosen what is better."

KEY IDEA

Opposition to Jesus increases.

KEY IDEA

Do not worry. Be rich toward God.



FOUND IN Lk. 12:1–13:9



Jesus heals a crippled woman on the Sabbath.

KEY IDEA

Jesus' generosity toward her puts his opponents to shame.




FOUND IN Lk. 13:10–17




Jesus heals a man born blind.

KEY IDEA


"I and the Father are one."



Jesus teaches about entering the kingdom of God.

KEY IDEA

Enter through the narrow door.







Jesus mourns over Jerusalem.

KEY IDEA

"I have longed to gather your children together."



Jesus dines with Pharisees, heals a man with dropsy, and tells the parable of the great banquet.

KEY IDEA

Those who exalt themselves will be humbled, but the truly humble will be exalted.



Jesus tells the large crowds what it means to follow him.

KEY IDEA

Count the cost first.

Carry your cross and follow Jesus.



FOUND IN Lk. 14:25–35



Jesus tells the parables of the lost sheep, the lost coin, and the lost son (prodigal son).

KEY IDEA

There is rejoicing in heaven over every person who repents.



FOUND IN Mt. 18:12–14; Lk. 15:1–32



Jesus tells the parable of the shrewd manager.

KEY IDEA

You cannot serve both God and money.



Jesus tells the story of the beggar Lazarus and the rich man.

KEY IDEA

Some will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.



FOUND IN Lk. 16:19–31

Jesus teaches about forgiveness, faith, and duty.

KEY IDEA

Faith, even as small as a mustard seed, is powerful.







In Bethany, Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead.

KEY IDEA

"The one who believes in me will live."







After learning that Jesus raised Lazarus, many people believe in Jesus.

In response, the Sanhedrin plots to kill Jesus in Jerusalem.

KEY IDEA


The high priest, Caiaphas, prophesied that Jesus would die for all God's people.

Jesus heals ten men with leprosy, but only one returns to thank Jesus.

"Your faith has made you well."

Jesus tells the parable of the persistent widow.

Pray and don't give up.

"With God all things are possible."








Jesus tells the parable of the vineyard workers.

"The last will be first, and the first will be last."








Jesus again predicts his death and resurrection.

"Salvation has come to this house."








In Bethany, Mary (Martha's sister) anoints Jesus with expensive perfume.

Jesus is anointed for burial before he enters Jerusalem.











