## EVENT

Jesus is rejected in his hometown.

## KEY IDEA

“A prophet is not without honor except in his own town.”

**FOUND IN** Mt. 13:53–58; Mk. 6:1–6; Lk. 4:16–30

## EVENT

Jesus commissions the twelve disciples.

## KEY IDEA

“I am sending you out like sheep among wolves.”

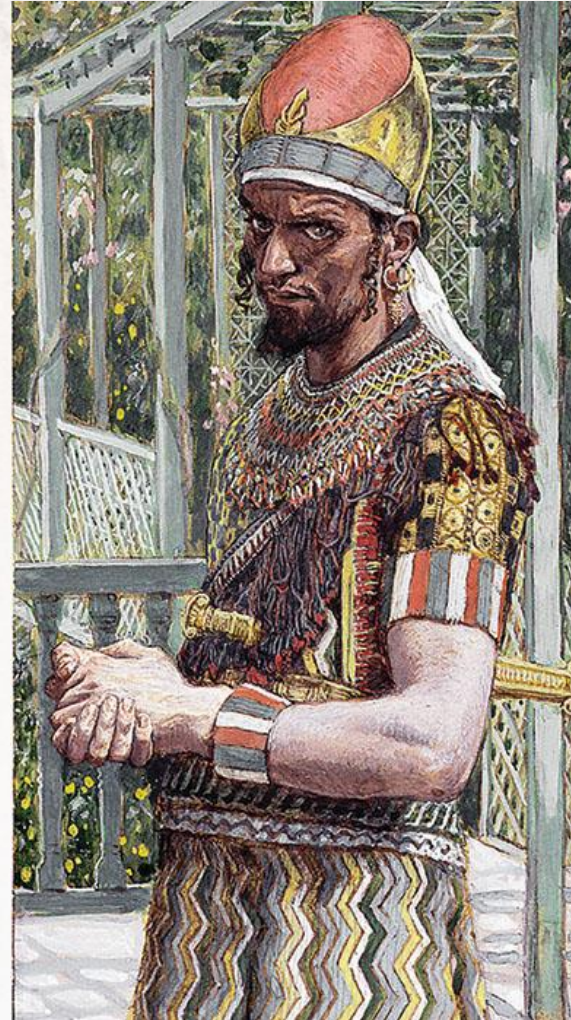
**FOUND IN** Mt. 9:35–10:42; Mk. 6:7–13; Lk. 9:1–6

## EVENT

Herod Antipas has John the Baptist executed.

## KEY IDEA

Herod later fears that John has been resurrected as Jesus.



**FOUND IN** Mt. 14:1–12; Mk. 6:14–29; Lk. 9:7–9

## EVENT

Jesus feeds 5,000 people with five loaves and two fish.

## KEY IDEA

Jesus shows compassion for the crowd.

**FOUND IN** Mt. 14:13–21;  
Mk. 6:30–44; Lk. 9:10–17;  
Jn. 6:1–15

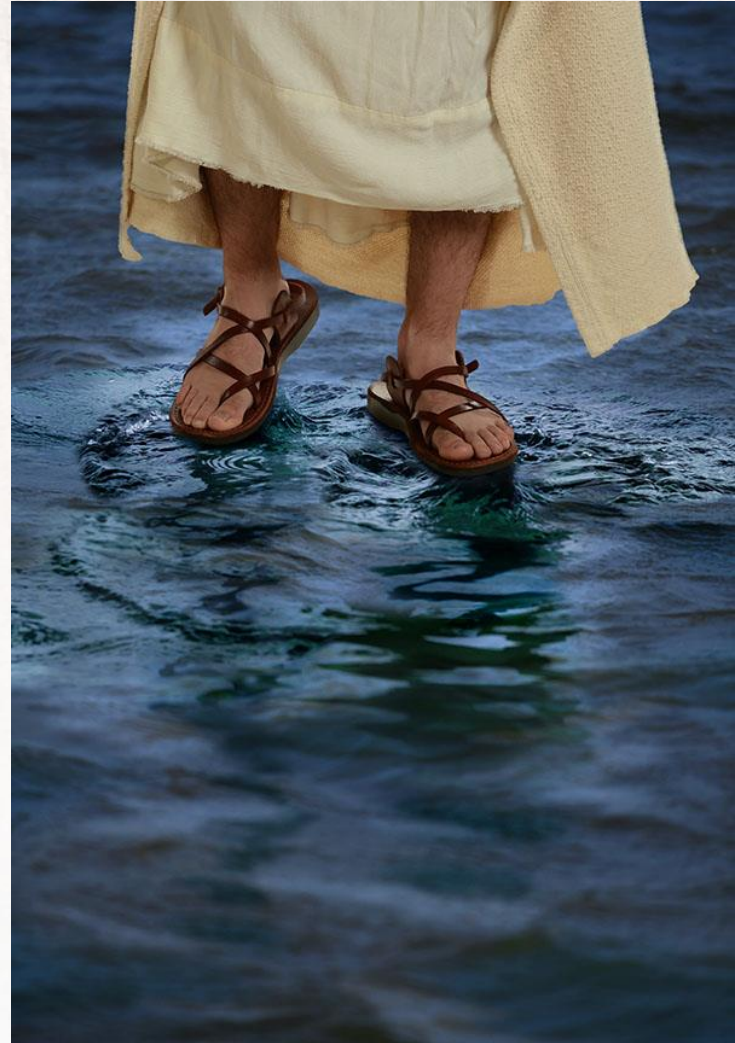


## EVENT

Jesus walks on water on the Sea of Galilee.

## KEY IDEA

The disciples acknowledge that Jesus is the Son of God.



**FOUND IN** Mt. 14:22–36; Mk. 6:45–56; Jn. 6:16–21



## EVENT

Jesus teaches about the true bread from heaven.

## KEY IDEA

“I am the bread of life.”



**FOUND IN** Jn. 6:22–71

## EVENT

Jesus teaches about inner versus outer cleanliness.

## KEY IDEA

Honor Jesus from your heart.

**FOUND IN** Mt. 15:1–20; Mk. 7:1–23

## EVENT

Jesus heals a woman's daughter in the region of Tyre and Sidon.

## KEY IDEA

A non-Israelite shows great faith in Jesus.

**FOUND IN** Mt. 15:21–28; Mk. 7:24–30

## EVENT

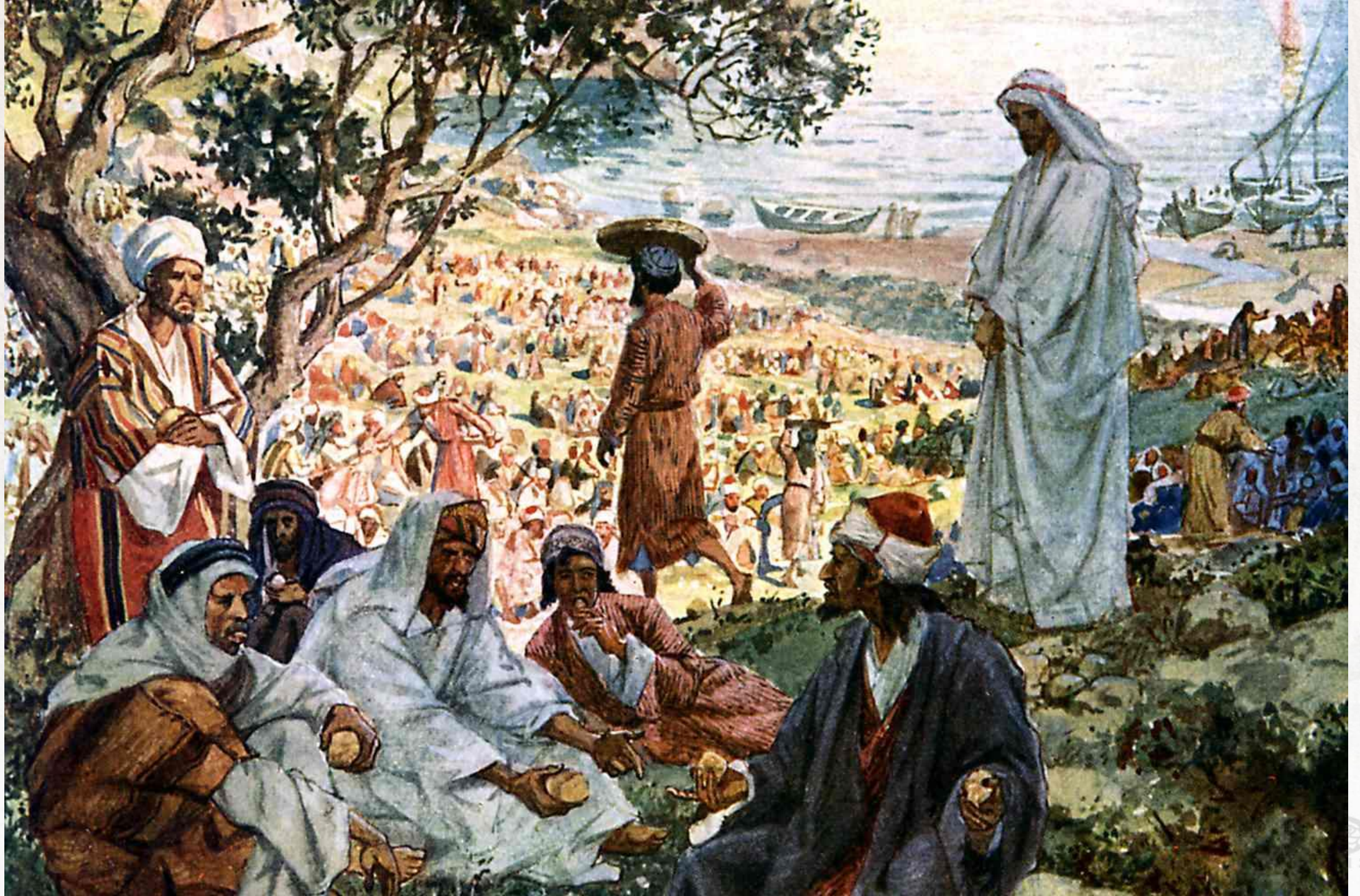
Jesus heals a deaf and mute man.

## KEY IDEA

“Be opened!”

**FOUND IN** Mk. 7:31–37





## EVENT

The Pharisees and Sadducees ask Jesus for a sign.

## KEY IDEA

No sign given except the sign of Jonah.

“Be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees.”

**FOUND IN** Mt. 16:1–12; Mk. 8:11–21

## EVENT

Jesus heals a blind man at Bethsaida.

## KEY IDEA

Jesus tells the man not to announce his healing.

**FOUND IN** Mk. 8:22–26

## EVENT

Peter calls Jesus the Messiah—the Christ.

## KEY IDEA

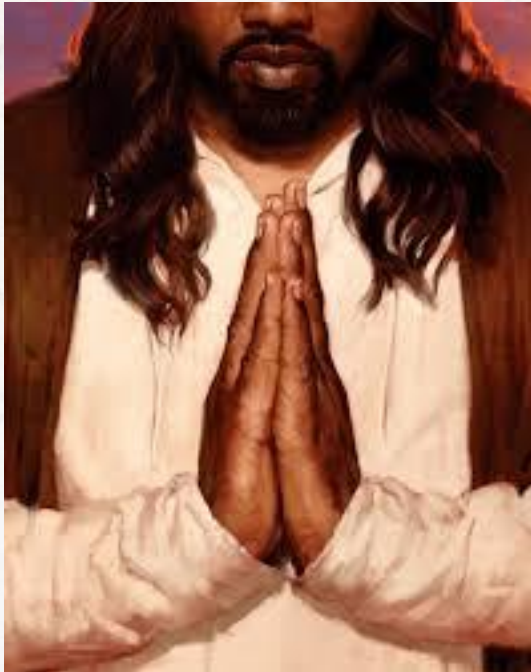
“You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.”

**FOUND IN** Mt. 16:13–20; Mk. 8:27–30; Lk. 9:18–21



## EVENT

Jesus predicts his death and resurrection.



## KEY IDEA

“The Son of Man must suffer many things.”

**FOUND IN** Mt. 16:21–28;  
Mk. 8:31–9:1; Lk. 9:22–27

## EVENT

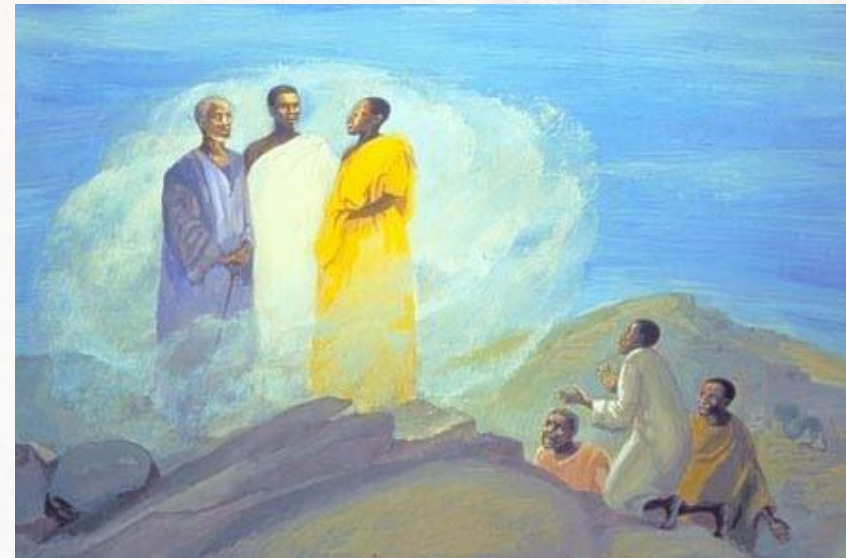
### **The Transfiguration:**

Jesus is seen in glory. Moses and Elijah appear.

## KEY IDEA

A voice from a cloud proclaims,  
“This is my Son, whom I love.”

**FOUND IN** Mt. 17:1–13; Mk. 9:2–13; Lk. 9:28–36





## EVENT

Jesus heals a boy who is possessed by a demon.

## KEY IDEA

Faith as small as a mustard seed moves mountains.

**FOUND IN** Mt. 17:14–20, (v. 21\*); Mk. 9:14–29; Lk. 9:37–43

\*Some early manuscripts do not have this verse.

## EVENT

Again, Jesus predicts his death and resurrection.

## KEY IDEA

Jesus will be killed and on the third day be raised to life.

**FOUND IN** Mt. 17:22–23; Mk. 9:30–32; Lk. 9:44–45

## EVENT

Jesus teaches about the temple tax, children, true greatness, and mercy.

## KEY IDEA

“It is the one who is least among you all who is the greatest.”

**FOUND IN** Mt. 17:24–18:35; Mk. 9:33–50; Lk. 9:46–50

## KEY IDEA

Jesus' ministry shifts from Galilee to Judea and Perea (“across the Jordan”).



**FOUND IN** Mt. 19:1–2; Mk. 10:1; Lk. 9:51–56; Jn. 7:1–14

## EVENT

Jesus teaches about the cost of following him.

## KEY IDEA

“The Son of Man has no place to lay his head.”

**FOUND IN** Mt. 8:18–22; Lk. 9:57–62

## EVENT

Jesus teaches in the temple courts in Jerusalem.

## KEY IDEA

“I am not here on my own authority.”



**FOUND IN** Jn. 7:15–52

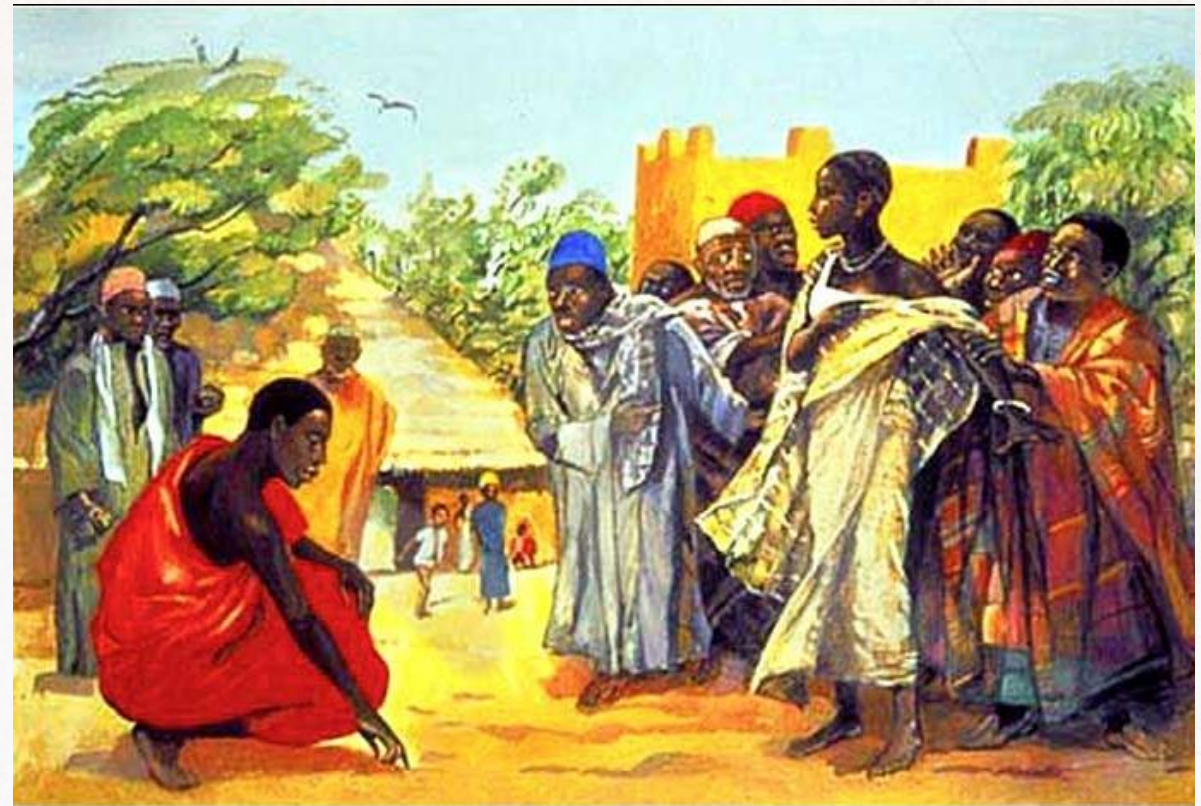
## EVENT

In the temple courts, Jesus spares a woman who was caught in adultery.

## KEY IDEA

The Pharisees are outwitted by Jesus.

FOUND IN Jn. 7:53–8:11\*



## EVENT

Jesus has disputes with the Pharisees at the temple courts.

## KEY IDEA

God the Father has sent Jesus.

Jesus tells the Pharisees, “If you knew me, you would know my Father also.”

**FOUND IN** Jn. 8:12–58

## EVENT

Jesus sends out the seventy-two.

## KEY IDEA

The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few.

FOUND IN Lk. 10:1–24



## EVENT

Jesus tells the parable of the good Samaritan.

## KEY IDEA

“Love your neighbor as yourself.”

FOUND IN Lk. 10:25–37

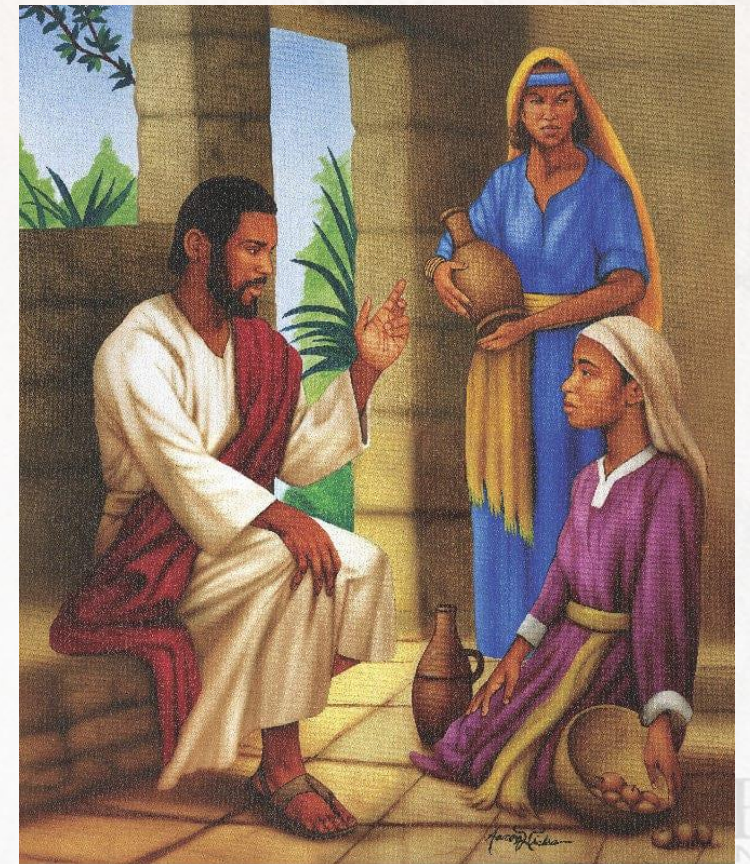


## EVENT

Jesus visits the home of Martha and Mary in Bethany.

## KEY IDEA

“Mary has chosen what is better.”



FOUND IN Lk. 10:38–42

## EVENT

Jesus pronounces judgment upon a wicked generation.

## KEY IDEA

Opposition to Jesus increases.

**FOUND IN** Lk. 11:14–54



## EVENT

Jesus teaches about courage, true riches, and recognizing the times.

## KEY IDEA

Do not worry. Be rich toward God.

**FOUND IN** Lk. 12:1–13:9



## EVENT

Jesus heals a crippled woman on the Sabbath.

## KEY IDEA

Jesus' generosity toward her puts his opponents to shame.



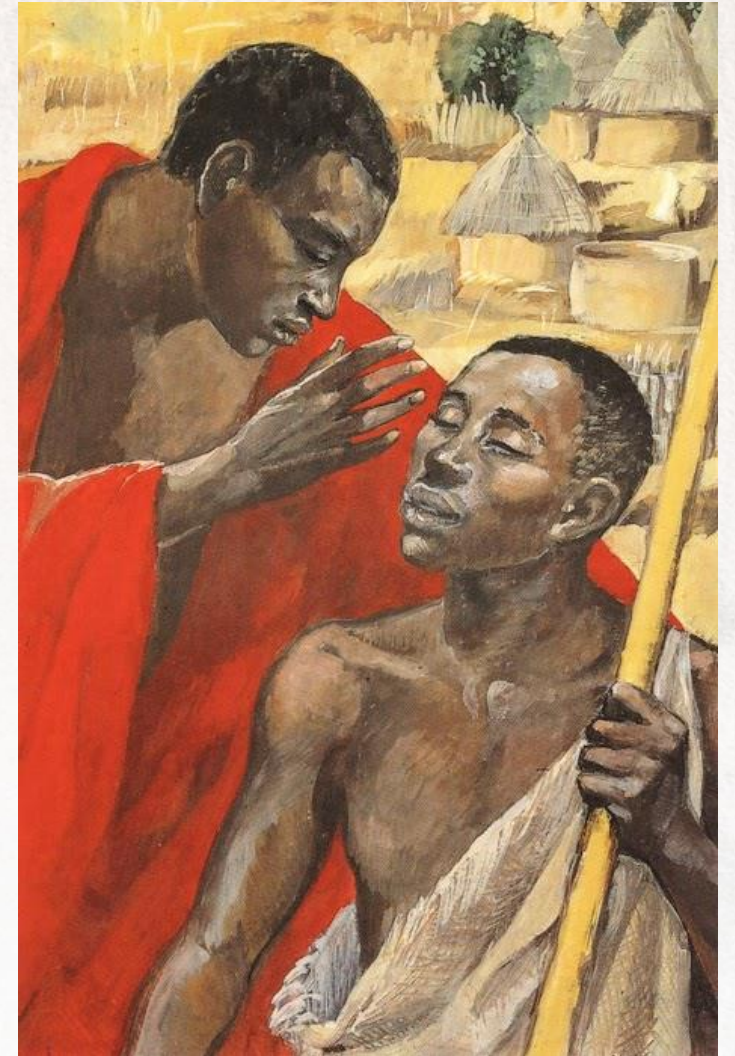
**FOUND IN** Lk. 13:10–17

## EVENT

Jesus heals a man born blind.

## KEY IDEA

“I am the light of the world.”



FOUND IN Jn. 9:1–41

## EVENT

Jesus says that he is the Good Shepherd.

## KEY IDEA

“I know my sheep and my sheep know me.”

FOUND IN Jn. 10:1–21



## EVENT

Some try to kill Jesus for blasphemy.

## KEY IDEA

“I and the Father are one.”

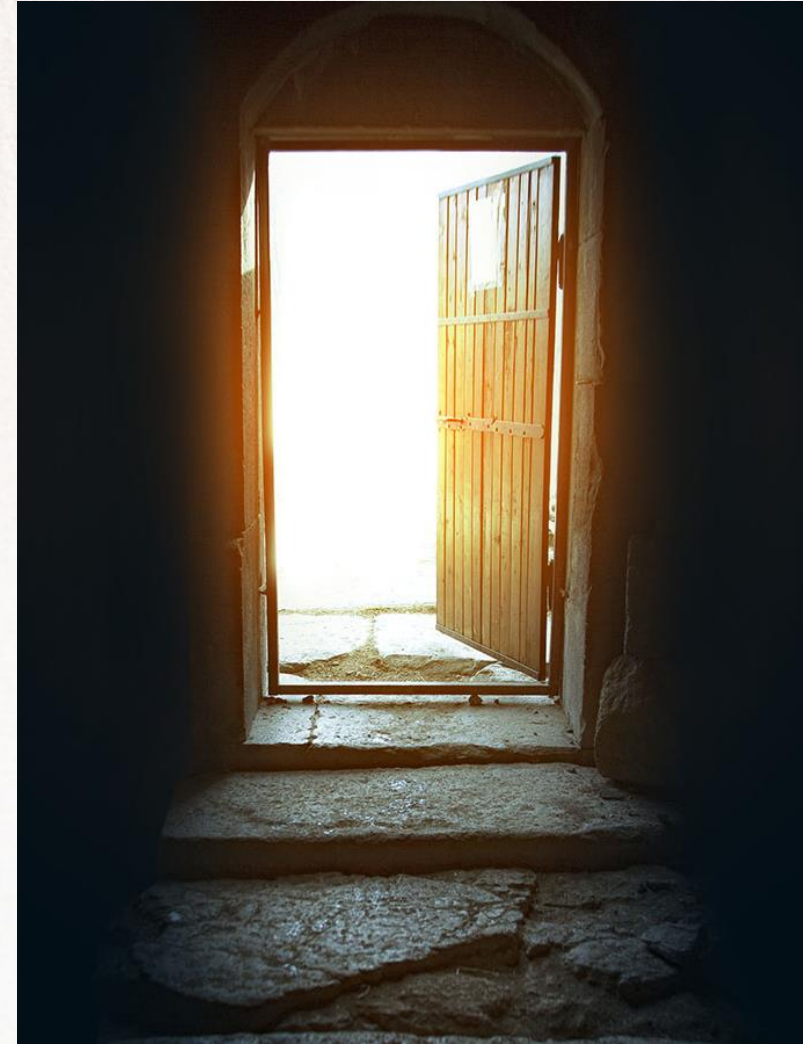
**FOUND IN** Jn. 10:22–42

## EVENT

Jesus teaches about entering the kingdom of God.

## KEY IDEA

Enter through the narrow door.



FOUND IN Lk. 13:22–30

## EVENT

Jesus mourns  
over Jerusalem.

## KEY IDEA

“I have longed to gather  
your children together.”



**FOUND IN** Mt. 23:37–39; Lk. 13:31–35

## EVENT

Jesus dines with Pharisees, heals a man with dropsy, and tells the parable of the great banquet.

## KEY IDEA

Those who exalt themselves will be humbled, but the truly humble will be exalted.

**FOUND IN** Lk. 14:1–24



## EVENT

Jesus tells the large crowds what it means to follow him.

## KEY IDEA

Count the cost first.  
Carry your cross and follow Jesus.



**FOUND IN** Lk. 14:25–35

## EVENT

Jesus tells the parables of the lost sheep, the lost coin, and the lost son (prodigal son).

## KEY IDEA

There is rejoicing in heaven over every person who repents.



**FOUND IN** Mt. 18:12–14; Lk. 15:1–32

## EVENT

Jesus tells the parable of the shrewd manager.

## KEY IDEA

You cannot serve both God and money.

**FOUND IN** Lk. 16:1–15

## EVENT

Jesus tells the story of the beggar Lazarus and the rich man.

## KEY IDEA

Some will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.

FOUND IN Lk. 16:19–31



## EVENT

Jesus teaches about forgiveness, faith, and duty.

## KEY IDEA

Faith, even as small as a mustard seed, is powerful.



**FOUND IN** Lk. 17:1–10

## EVENT

In Bethany, Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead.

## KEY IDEA

“The one who believes in me will live.”



FOUND IN Jn. 11:1–44

## EVENT

After learning that Jesus raised Lazarus, many people believe in Jesus.

In response, the Sanhedrin plots to kill Jesus in Jerusalem.

## KEY IDEA

The high priest, Caiaphas, prophesied that Jesus would die for all God's people.

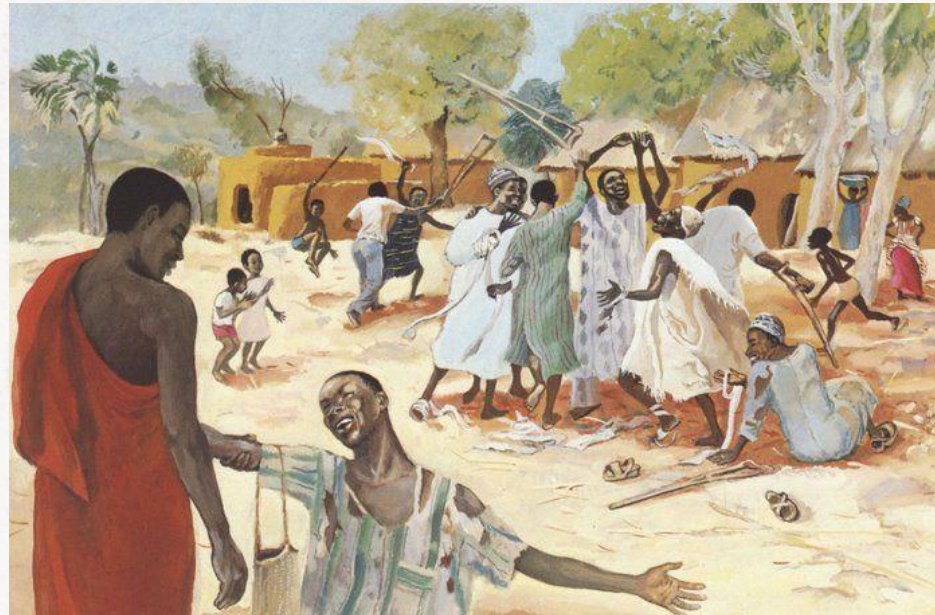
**FOUND IN** Jn. 11:45–57

## EVENT

Jesus heals ten men with leprosy, but only one returns to thank Jesus.

## KEY IDEA

“Your faith has made you well.”



FOUND IN Lk. 17:11–19



## EVENT

Jesus teaches about the coming of the kingdom and the last days.

## KEY IDEA

“The kingdom of God is in your midst.”

**FOUND IN** Lk. 17:20–37

## EVENT

Jesus tells the parable of the persistent widow.

## KEY IDEA

Pray and don't give up.



**FOUND IN** Lk. 18:1–8

## EVENT

Jesus tells the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector who went to the temple to pray.



## KEY IDEA

The humble are the truly righteous.



FOUND IN Lk. 18:9–14

## EVENT

Jesus teaches about marriage, divorce, and the law.

## KEY IDEA

“What God has joined together, let no one separate.”

**FOUND IN** Mt. 19:1–12; Mk. 10:2–12; Lk. 16:18

## EVENT

Jesus teaches about children.

## KEY IDEA

God's kingdom belongs to children.



**FOUND IN** Mt. 19:13–15; Mk. 10:13–16; Lk. 18:15–17

## EVENT

Jesus tells a rich young ruler to give his wealth to the poor.

## KEY IDEA

“With God all things are possible.”



**FOUND IN** Mt. 19:16–30; Mk. 10:17–31; Lk. 18:18–30

## EVENT

Jesus tells the parable of the vineyard workers.

## KEY IDEA

“The last will be first, and the first will be last.”



**FOUND IN** Mt. 20:1–16



## EVENT

Jesus again predicts his death and resurrection.

## KEY IDEA

Jesus heads toward Jerusalem, knowing he will be killed there.

**FOUND IN** Mt. 20:17–19; Mk. 10:32–34; Lk. 18:31–34



## EVENT

The disciples James and John ask for positions of honor in Christ's kingdom.

## KEY IDEA

If you want to be great, become a servant of all.

**FOUND IN** Mt. 20:20–28; Mk. 10:35–45

## EVENT

Jesus heals Bartimaeus and another blind man in Jericho.

## KEY IDEA

Jesus gives sight to the blind.



**FOUND IN** Mt. 20:29–34;  
Mk. 10:46–52; Lk. 18:35–43

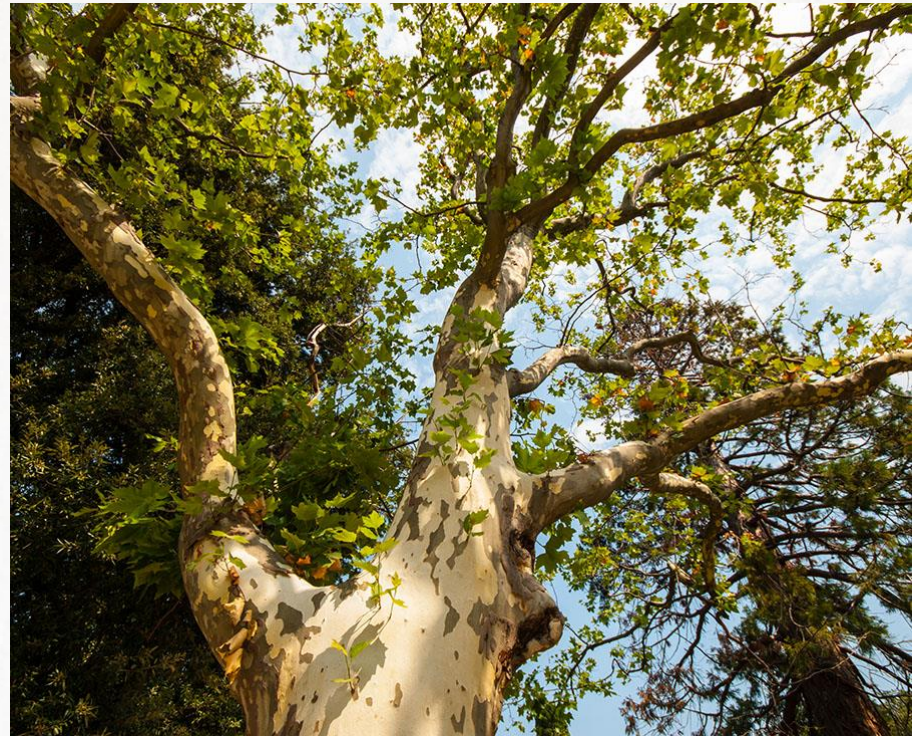
## EVENT

After climbing a tree to see Jesus, Zacchaeus, a chief tax collector in Jericho, welcomes Jesus into his home.



## KEY IDEA

“Salvation has come to this house.”



**FOUND IN** Lk. 19:1–27

## EVENT

In Bethany, Mary (Martha's sister) anoints Jesus with expensive perfume.

## KEY IDEA

Jesus is anointed for burial before he enters Jerusalem.



**FOUND IN** Mt. 26:6–13; Mk. 14:3–9; Jn. 12:1–11

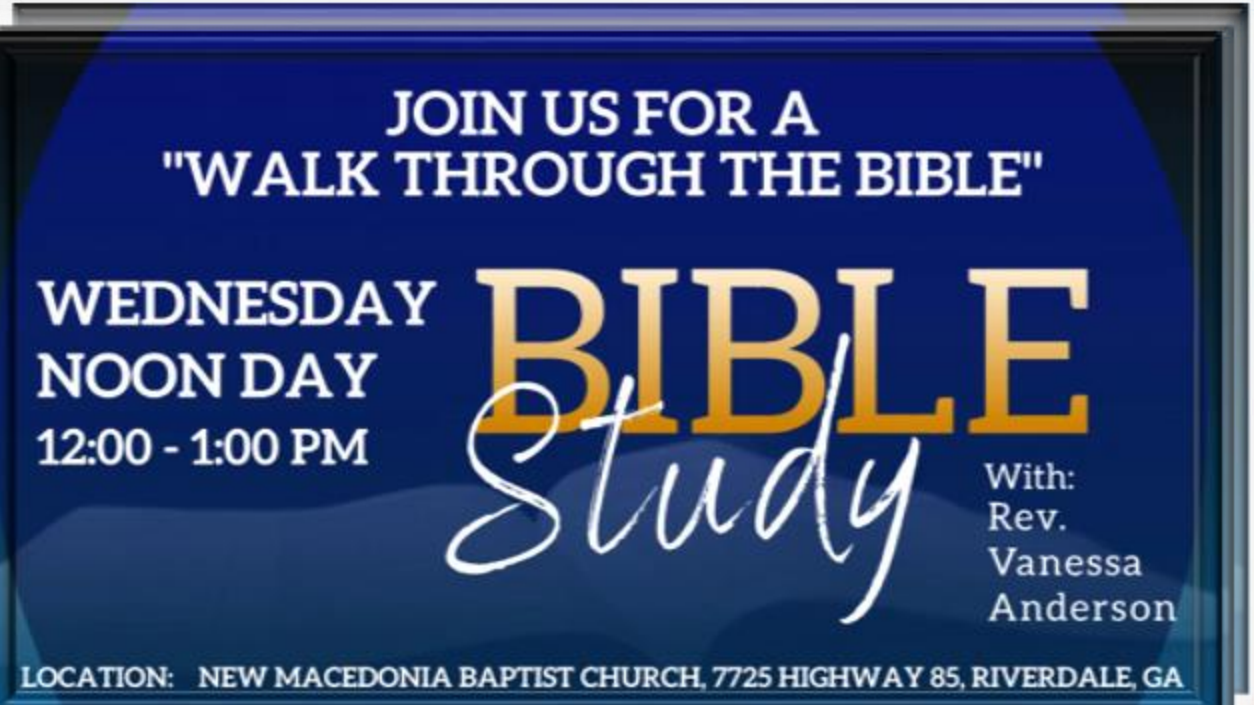

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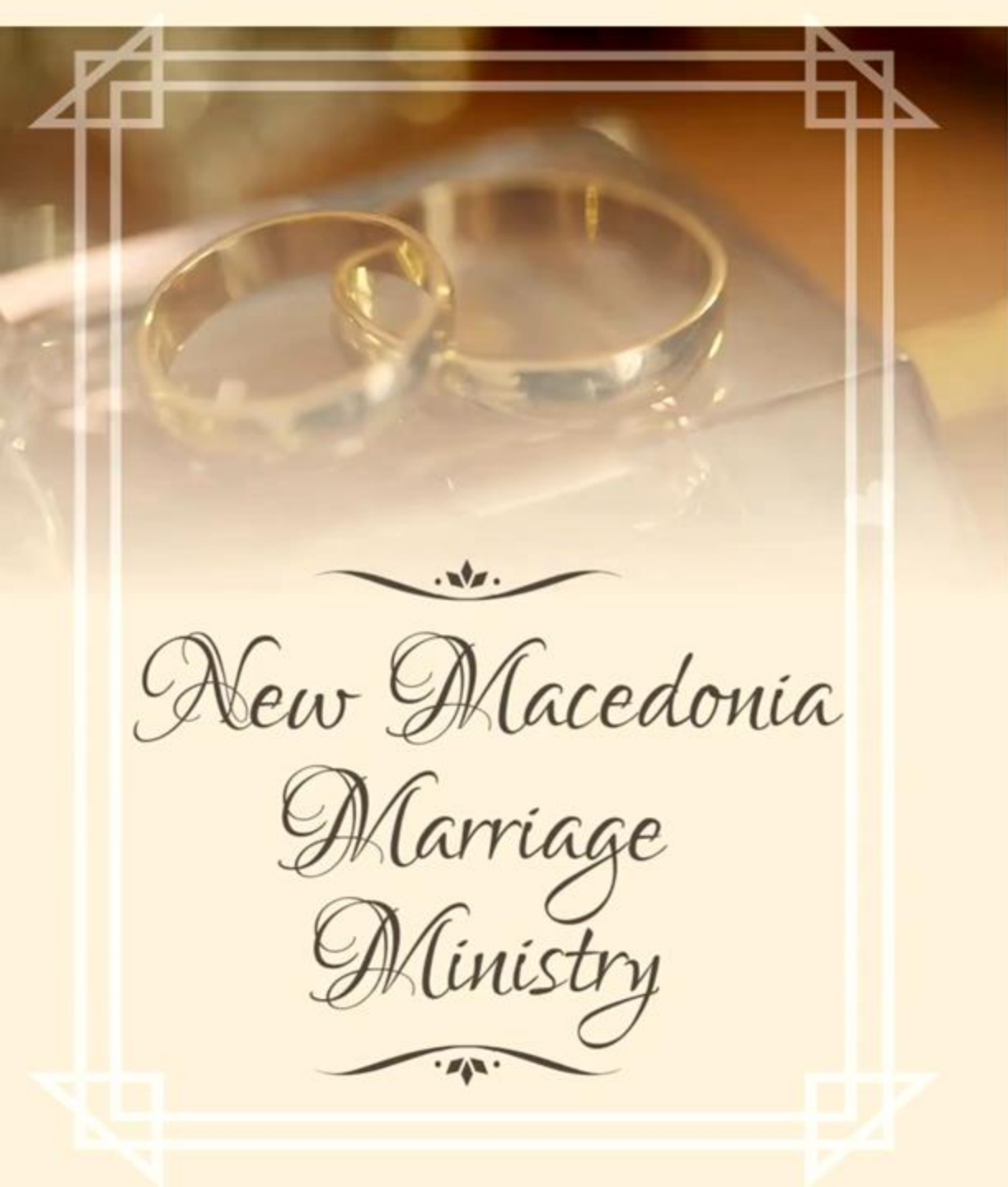
